

## 50% Fares for Total Mobility Card Holders

Total Mobility journeys will have an additional discount applied to the already subsidised fare from 1 April 2022 - 31 January 2023. This has been made available as part of the Government's 50% Public Transport Initiative.

The discount will be applied to the portion of the trip that you would normally pay for. The regional subsidy cap is still in place, however. Here are some examples of how this might look for you:
