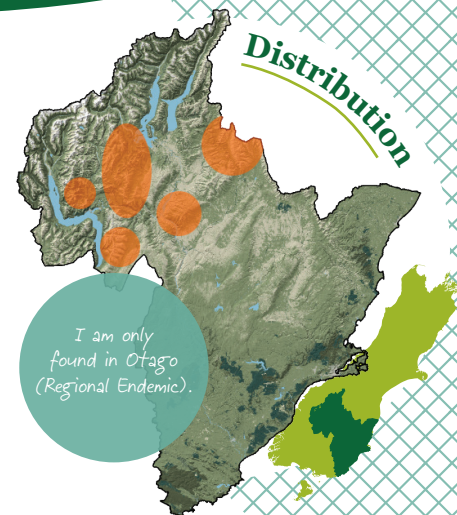

V-shaped marking often present between eyes

Steep, high mountain slopes with lots of exposed rock (e.g. scree slopes) and snow tussock.



I eat...

Mostly small invertebrates, including insects (e.g. moths and wētā) and spiders
Flower nectar and native fruits when available
