1 Otago Regional Council gives notice of its intention to appear and be heard on the appeal brought by Te Rūnanga o Moeraki, Kāti Huirapa Rūnaka ki Puketeraki, Te Rūnanga o Ōtākou and Hokonui Rūnanga (collectively, “Kāi Tahu ki Otago” or “Kā Rūnaka”); Te Ao Marama Incorporated on behalf of Waihopai Rūnaka, Te Rūnanga o Ōraka Aparima, and Te Rūnanga o Awarua (collectively, “Ngāi Tahu ki Murihiku”); and Te Rūnanga o Ngāi Tahu together referred to as “Kāi Tahu” against the decisions of the Otago Regional Council to accept some of the Freshwater Hearing Panel’s recommendations on the freshwater planning instrument parts of the Proposed Otago Regional Policy Statement 2021.
