- Forest & Bird made a submission and further submission on the Proposed Otago Regional Policy Statement.
- 3. Forest & Bird is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C or 308CA of the Resource Management Act 1991.
- 4. Forest & Bird has an interest greater than the public generally as an incorporated society with a well-known role in the protection of indigenous biodiversity.¹
- Forest & Bird is interested in all of the proceedings other than SRMR Introduction and Figure 2 and SRMR-I10.
- 6. Forest & Bird **opposes** the relief sought in relation to all parts of the appeal.

 - a. are not consistent with the Act;
