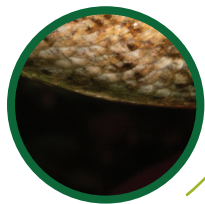

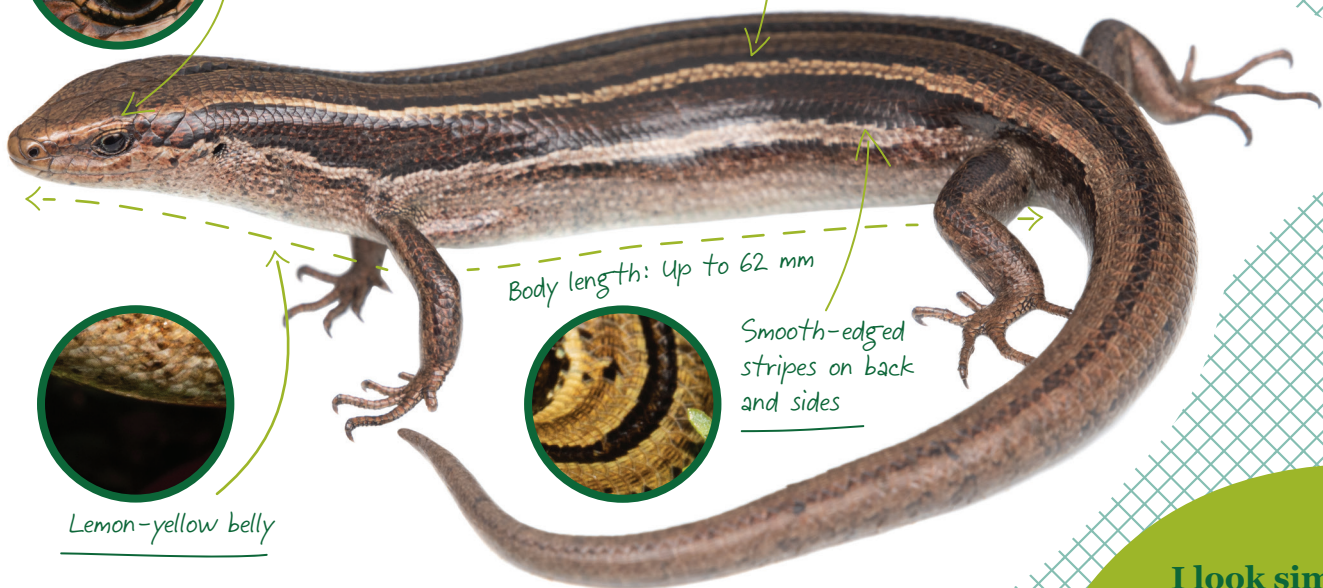
Three large scales
