1. The Royal Forest and Bird Protection Society of New Zealand Incorporated (**Forest & Bird**) wishes to be a party to the following proceedings:
  - a. ENV-2024-CHC-35 *Transpower New Zealand Limited v Otago Regional Council*
2. Forest & Bird made a submission and further submission on the Proposed Otago Regional Policy Statement.
3. Forest & Bird is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C or 308CA of the Resource Management Act 1991.
4. Forest & Bird has an interest greater than the public generally as an incorporated society with a well-known role in the protection of indigenous biodiversity.<sup>1</sup>
5. Forest & Bird is interested in all of the proceedings.
6. Forest & Bird **opposes** the relief sought in relation to all parts of the appeal. The Appellant seeks amendments that:
  - a. are not consistent with the Act;
  - b. do not give effect to higher order policy including the New Zealand Coastal Policy Statement and National Policy Statement for Freshwater Management;
  - c. will not ensure that ecosystems are safeguarded;
  - d. do not meet the mandatory statutory obligations placed on the Respondent by s 30; and
  - e. do not represent sound resource management practice.
7. Forest & Bird agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceeding.
