Good afternoon Karina

Further to counsel for ORC's email to the parties below, we are due to provide finalised positions for the above mediation by 5pm today. The agreed sequencing requires appellants to first provide their positions, before s 274 parties

To date, and as per counsel for Transpower and Port Otago's email below, we are still awaiting positions for two appellants – Dunedin City Council and the Cain Whānau.

Without those positions, there is precious little for the s 274 parties to respond to (beyond the Regional Council's position).

We would be grateful if this request could be provided to the Commissioner, and for the following directions to be made:

- Any finalised positions for appellants, if to be provided by **midday tomorrow** (at the latest).
- Any positions for s 274 parties to be provided by **midday Thursday**, with access to the document to be closed off at that point.

Counsel has spoken to Ms Scott for Transpower and Port Otago and understand that she supports an approach, whereby the position papers would be completed (in full) prior to closing off the document, and delivery to the Commissioner.
